



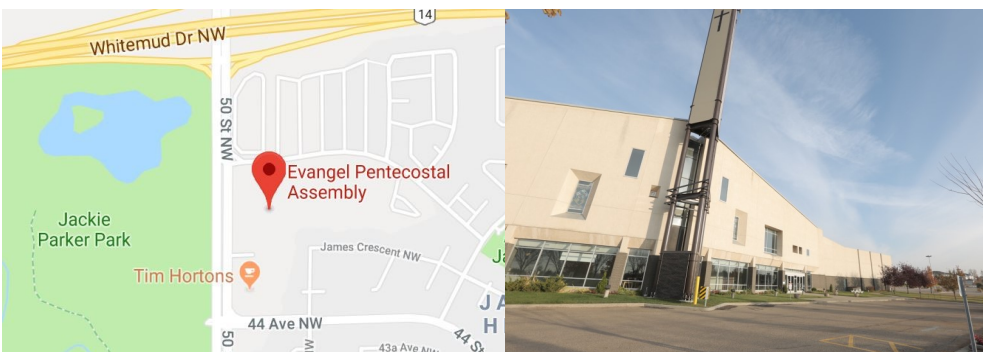
Emergency shelters, food banks, soup kitchens... Can we do better to help struggling people and families across our city?
